TURKISH STATEMENT.

CONSTANTINOPLE, August 18, via London, August 19: In the Dardanelles district at Anafarta on the 16th we repulsed an attack of an enemy division against our right wing...

AUSTRIAN STATEMENT.

VIENNA, August 18, via London, August 19: On the 18th, while the German forces advanced along the west bank of the Bug, the troops under command of Lieut. Field Marshal von Arz repulsed the Russians on both sides of the road from Biala within range of the fortress artillery of Brest-Litovsk...

RUSSIAN STATEMENT.

ST. PETERSBURG, August 18, via London, August 19: In the district of Riga and in the direction of Jacobstadt there has been no important change in the direction of Dvinsk on the night of the 16th and the day of the 17th we repulsed German attempts to pass to the offensive...

GERMAN STATEMENT.

BERLIN, August 19: Army group of Field Marshal von Hindenburg: On the occasion of capturing Kovno an additional thirty officers and 3,900 men were taken prisoners. Under pressure of the loss of Kovno the Russians were obliged to evacuate their positions opposite Kalvarija and Suwalki...

ITALIAN STATEMENT.

ROME, via Paris, August 19: Along the Tyrol and Trentino frontiers our artillery fire continues intense and effective. In the valley of Backer (Sexten) during the day of the 17th our troops conquered a second line of trenches. Although the enemy withdrew rapidly before our pursuit, we took two officers and forty soldiers and a quantity of rifles, ammunition and other war materials...

FRENCH STATEMENT.

PARIS, August 19, 2:35 p.m.: There was much activity last night on the Artois front. An attack by our forces made us masters of the junction of the highroads between Bethune and Arras and between Abain and Angres, where the German position constituted a salient into our advance line...

BRITISH STATEMENT.
