Marriage of Miss Carbo and Mr. Jones This Afternoon.

Engagement Announced of Miss Kohly of Cuba and Mr. Godoy of This City—Notes.

Rev. Father Mills, assistant rector of St. Matthew's Church, will perform the ceremony at the marriage this afternoon at 4 o'clock of Miss Maria Angello Carbo and Mr. Willis Roscoe Jones of Baltimore, who is to take place at the home of the bride's mother, Mrs. Carbo, widow of the late minister to this country from Ecuador.

The house has been elaborately decorated for the occasion. The front drawing room, where the ceremony will take place, has been converted into a veritable bower with palms, autumn leaves and great clusters of white chrysanthemums.

The ceremony will be performed at the farther end between the windows, with a background of trailing vines and palms.

The bridal procession, which will form upstairs, will pass down the staircase and across the spacious hall into the drawing room, where the bridegroom, attended by his brother, Dr. Paul Jones of North Carolina, will await the bride.

The bride will be escorted by her oldest brother, Mr. Luis Alberto Carbo of London, and she will wear one of the handsomest wedding gowns seen this season. The foundation is of heavy white satin almost entirely covered with pearl embroidery. The V-necked bodice is of the satin with a high lace ruff showing on the back.

A panel of lace, caught on either side with tiny clusters of orange blossoms extends down the front of the dress to the hem, and the court train, also of the pearl-embroidered satin, is suspended from the shoulders.

She will wear a tulle veil, caught close to the hair in cap fashion with a wreath of orange blossoms and the bridegroom's gift, a pearl and diamond tassel. A bouquet of bride roses and Shies of the valley will be carried.

Miss Anna Christina Carbo, sister of the bride, will be the maid of honor, and she will wear a gown of changeable pale blue and gold taffeta, made with a full skirt, ruffled to the waist, each ruffle being edged with white rosebuds and tulle. The square-necked bodice is of taffeta and tulle trimmed with narrow ruffles and edged around the neck and the tiny puffed sleeves with rosebuds.

She will wear a wreath of rosebuds wound on tulle in her hair and carry a bouquet of yellow roses.

The bridesmaids will be Miss Maria Teresa Carbo, another sister of the bride; Miss Mercedes Godoy, Miss Carlota-Aroze, Miss Hortensia Coronado. They will wear charming gowns of changeable yellow chiffon taffeta, with full round length skirts and bodices of yellow tulle and chiffon, caught at the left side with bouquets of pink and blue rosebuds.

They will wear wreaths of yellow rosebuds and gold bands in their hair and carry bouquets of pink roses.

The ushers will be Mr. Charles M. Gosnell and Mr. Edward E. Lowndes of Baltimore, Mr. Raymond J. Dunworth of Philadelphia, and the bride's brother, Mr. Esteban Carbo.

A large reception will follow, when the guests will include a representative gathering from diplomatic, army, navy and resident circles.

The bride of today, with her sisters, has been a great favorite here in society since they arrived some years ago, when their father was appointed to a post here.

Mrs. Carbo, mother of the bride, will assist in receiving, wearing a gown of black satin, with black lace over white chiffon trimming the corsage. Mrs. S. H. Jones of Baltimore, mother of the bridegroom, will also assist in receiving.

Mr. and Mrs. Jones will leave later for their wedding trip, the latter wearing smart traveling suit of blue gabardine, with braid and fur trimming and a black velvet hat with a soft drooping brim, trimmed with a knot of roses in old rose shades and blue ribbon.

There were a large number of out-of-town guests present from Baltimore and other cities among them Dr. and Mrs. Paul Jones of North Carolina and Dr. and Mrs. Ward, also of North Carolina, the latter a sister of the bridegroom.
