Laden with 4,071 tons of coal, the big five-masted schooner Dorothy Palmer has sailed from Baltimore for Genoa, Italy.


A return cargo of salt will be loaded at Trapani, Sicily.

INSPECTION BOAT IN PORT.


Dixie Will Visit Oyster Boats to See That Laws Are Obedied.

George Julian Zolnay, the sculptor, expects to complete the frieze in about a month.


