DETAILS OF VICE GIVEN IN COMMISSION REPORT

Traffic in Babies Sensational Feature of Disclosures by Maryland Investigators.

Baltimore Institution Buries 5,000 Infants in Plot Fifty-Five Feet Square, It Is Declared.

Probably the most sensational of the features dealt with in the report of the state-wide vice commission named by Governor Goldsborough in January, 1915, made public yesterday, is the alleged traffic in babies. It is asserted that investigators found there are institutions in Baltimore to which the mother of an illegitimate child may consign her offspring upon the payment of an agreed-upon sum and thereby rid herself of legal responsibility for it.

Cause of High Death Rate. The high death rate is attributed to the separation of the infant from its mother at birth, thereby depriving it of the individual attention it would have otherwise received. No evidence was adduced that the babies were neglected at the institutions.

Since the commission began its work in the "red light" districts here formerly tolerated by the authorities, according to the report, however, there is no evidence that immorality is not practiced as extensively as ever. Much of this evil is practiced clandestinely, says the commission and business resorts in the "red light" districts here formerly tolerated by the authorities.

RAILROAD WINS SUIT. Supreme Court Holds It Entitled to Collect Higher Freight Rate.

The Supreme Court has affirmed the action of the Tennessee supreme court in dismissing the suit by the Dayton (Tenn.) Coal and Iron Company, pig iron manufacturers, against the Cincinnati, New Orleans and Texas Railway Company, and others, to enjoin the roads from collecting in federal courts \$5,000 as additional freight charges.

The iron company claimed the Cincinnati Southern informed it that the charge for transporting certain ore would be 60 cents and that the rate was raised to 70 cents before the shipment could be completed.
