JUDGMENT FOR \$15,000 GIVEN STOCKBROKERS

Amount Due N. L. Carpenter & Co. From Sidney B. Harrison.

N. L. Carpenter & Co., stockbrokers, of New York, obtained a judgment today before Justice Gould in Circuit Division 1 of the District Supreme Court for \$15,000 against Sidney B. Harrison.

Claim for \$15,000 Only. Testimony offered to the jury today fixed the amount of the alleged defalcation of Harrison at about \$24,000, but as claim had been made only for \$15,000 the judgment was in that amount.

Suit was filed December 22, 1915, for \$15,000 against Sidney B. Harrison and Alice E. Malone to recover amounts alleged to be due from them to the firm for months past.

Judgment by Publication. Judgment by publication was obtained against Miss Malone, who has not returned to Washington since her departure in 1913.
