

# NATION-WIDE CRUSADE AGAINST POWER PLANT

### Campaign to Prevent Use of Water-Front Site Planned Tonight.

A nation-wide publicity campaign against erecting the government-owned central heat, light and power plant on the water-front site, as proposed, is to be inaugurated at a meeting of the committee of one hundred on the development of Washington with other art and architect society officials in the home of Hennen Jennings, Sheridan Circle, tonight at 8:30 o'clock.

Other matters of importance in the general scheme of development of the National Capital as a city beautiful will be considered, but the principal matter under discussion will be the power-plant site. The national commission of fine arts' contention is that the location of the plant, in the heart of the proposed parkway development, will destroy the beauty of the central park system and seriously mar the effect of memorials to the nation's founders and patriots. This subject will be discussed from all viewpoints—esthetic, architectural, patriotic, economic, efficiency, educational, engineering—by leaders in each branch.

### Spreading Propaganda.

This publicity campaign already has been taken up by three large organizations, the American Institute of Architects, the American Federation of Arts and the American Civic Association spreading the propaganda through their local branches in all the principal cities of the United States. It is proposed to create a great public sentiment against the proposed location of this power plant.

### Following Is Growing.

"The fundamental strength of the cause for which we are laboring has been felt throughout the ages, and is well expressed in that Latin axiom, 'Ars longa—vita brevis est,' said Mr. Mauran today in speaking of the rapidly growing following which is supporting the effort of the institute and the engineering and art societies allied with it, to secure a reconsideration of the Potomac channel site of the proposed power plant.
