

ASSEMBLY OF 2,000 FOR IRISH CAUSE

Meeting Held at Odd Fellows' Hall to Discuss Recent Revolt Against England.

APPEAL FOR SYMPATHY TO BE COUNTRY-WIDE

Address by Jeremiah O'Leary, Who Declares the People Were Driven to Rebellion.

An attempt to launch a nation-wide movement in sympathy with the Irish revolutionists was made at Odd Fellows' Hall last night at a mass meeting of 2,000 Irish-Americans, residents of the city.

The principal speaker of the evening was Jeremiah O'Leary of New York, president of the American Truth Society. The resolutions were presented by Dr. P. J. Lennox of the Catholic University of America.

Mr. O'Leary said the Irish were driven to revolt by secret orders issued by the British government to disarm men and organizations in Ireland.

Preparations are practically completed for the reception, luncheon and also the welcome by members of Congress at the Capitol to the suffrage envoys sent to tour the west by the Congressional Union and due to end their long trip in this city early tomorrow afternoon.

UNIQUE METHODS USED BY THE "BLIND TIGERS"

Officers in Georgia Uncover Various Schemes for Evasion of Prohibition Law.

ATLANTA, Ga., May 15.—Activities of officers to rigidly enforce Georgia's prohibition law that went into effect May 1 have disclosed some unique methods of "blind tigers" to evade the law.

Large Amount of Liquor Seized.

A general raid at 7:30 a. m. at Savannah, participated in by practically every member of the police force, resulted in confiscation of so much liquor that nearly every dray in the city was employed to haul it to the police station.

Reports from every section of the state, however, show that the new law is being lived up to with the exception of the comparatively few "blind tigers." Persons for and against prohibition point to this singular and far-reaching Savannah raid as evidence of this.

"Blind Tigers" Only Exception.

Liquor confiscated in the first thirteen days of May has run into the tens of thousands of gallons. The sheriff of Coffee county seized a portion of two carloads in the possession of the Ocella, Pineblum and Valdosta railroad, and out of that act has grown the first case of prohibition law.

To Enforce Prohibition Law.

CHARLESTON, W. Va., May 15.—The state department of prohibition will apply this week for injunctions against owners of steamboats to prohibit the carrying of labeled intoxicating liquors by passengers, according to an announcement made here.


