

WILL OF B. H. WARNER IS FILED FOR PROBATE

After Various Bequests, Estate Is Left in Trust, Income to Be Shared by Wife and Children.

The will of Brainard H. Warner, dated June 17, 1913, was filed today for probate. At the conclusion of the will appears the following statement: "I have long since declared it to be my intention to abandon any claim to citizenship in the state of Maryland."

DALLAS IS SELECTED FOR NEXT CONVENTION

Presbyterian Assembly Hopes for Stronger Merger Sentiment Southwest.

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., May 26.—Dallas, Tex., was selected today as the place of meeting of the 1917 General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States of America.

The vote was 365 for Dallas and 259 for St. Louis. It was announced that it would cost \$28,000 more in mileage expenses to take the 500 commissioners to Dallas than to St. Louis. To this the friends of Dallas replied that the Texas city would transport free of charge 500 commissioners.

LOCAL PALMIST CHARGED WITH IMPROPER CONDUCT

Edward S. Allen Arrested at Instigation of Police Matron, Acting in Role of Detective.

Charged with improper conduct toward Mrs. Sarah V. Farling, a police matron, who acted in the role of a detective, Edward S. Allen, a palmist, who occupied rooms on an upper floor at 124 1/2 street northwest, was arrested last night by Detectives Messer and Vermillion.

It is claimed by the police that the defendant's real name is Frank Heisman; that he is a native of this city and resided in Brightwood at the time of his arrest by Detectives Weedon and Howlett in 1902, at which time he was turned over to the Boston, Mass., police to answer a charge of having obtained \$2,000 from a woman in that city.

The defendant, the police state, last night told them he served three years in prison in Massachusetts for the Boston massacre. He has spent much of his time in the west since he left Massachusetts. It is stated, engaging in business under the names Leroy de Childrow, Leroy Childrow, Prof. Hale and Prof. Clark.

His arrest was the result of an investigation made by Mrs. Farling following complaints of his conduct toward women patrons who were attracted to his rooms through an advertisement suggesting that they should consult the psychic palmist when uncertainly blocked their paths.

Allen, as he gave his name when arrested, told the police he was divorced in this city a number of years ago. The warrant sworn out by Mrs. Farling charges assault.

Edward W. Fox, twenty-four years of age, his address at 30 C street northwest, who is said to have acted as Allen's secretary, this morning was placed under arrest and charged with assault, having been detained last night as a witness. He is held at the first police station.

Mrs. W. C. Johnson Asks Divorce.

Ruth Johnson has filed suit in the District Supreme Court for an absolute divorce from William C. Johnson, a florist. They were married June 3, 1911, and have two children. The wife alleges that her husband deserted her in June, 1915, and has transferred his affections to the children and the custody of the children, Attorney M. P. Morgan appears for the wife.


