MEXICO OUTBREAKS CAUSE UNEASINESS

Anti-American Demonstrations Cause Exodus of U. S. Citizens.

CARRANZISTAS THREATEN GEN. PERSHING'S PATROLS

Shots Exchanged With Bandits Over Rio Grande—Battle on the Rio Florida Near.

Administration officials were uneasy today over continued reports of anti-American demonstrations in northern Mexico.

Most demonstrations have gone no further than mass meetings and speeches by agitators who resent the presence of American troops on Mexican soil.

In the states of Chihuahua, San Luis Potosi and Nuevo Leon anti-American demonstrations have been particularly numerous, and attacks on American property were reported from Chihuahua and Monterey, where there are no consular agencies.

Carranzistas Threaten. COLUMBUS, N. M., June 10.—American scout patrols with Gen. Pershing's army in Mexico have been threatened with an attack by Carranzista troops, according to authoritative information received here today.


