

BARTON MEMORIAL FUND NOW \$27,000 Campaign in Honor of Civil War Nurse Will Be Continued.

ASSOCIATION HAS PLANS TO USE MOVING PICTURES Organization Will Be Perpetual and Nation-Wide, With State and Local Branches.

Since the movement was started for the erection of a Clara Barton memorial about \$27,000 has been raised, according to an announcement made at a meeting Friday of the Clara Barton Memorial Association at the Raleigh Hotel, Mrs. John A. Logan presiding.

Plans for the carrying on of the campaign to raise the funds for the memorial were discussed at the meeting. An offer has been received from the management of the Madison Square Garden, New York city, for a large meeting to be held in the fall.

It is proposed by the organization to raise \$200,000, and a plan is now under discussion to use half of this money for a memorial to Miss Barton in marble or bronze in Washington, and the other half to establish a fund from which each year a prize shall be awarded to the American woman doing the greatest work for humanity during that year.
