

RUSSIANS CLOSING UPON KOLOMEA Heavy Battles Proceeding East of Important Junction. Slavs Score Big Victory.

LONDON, June 30.—That the Russians are slowly but surely closing in on Kolomea, Galicia, is shown by both the Russian and Austrian official reports. Heavy battles are proceeding east of this important railroad junction, in which the Russians have captured three lines of Austrian trenches, compelling the Austrians to retire their lines southward. Kolomea is now closely pressed from both the north and east, while to the southeast the Russian occupation of Kimpolung in Bukovina opens all routes into Hungary.

ESTATE OF \$830,000 LEFT BY KITCHENER

LONDON, June 28.—The will of Field Marshal Earl Kitchener, the British secretary of war, who lost his life in the sinking of the cruiser Hampshire off the Orkneys June 5, was admitted to probate today. It shows that he left an estate valued at £173,429 sterling (approximately \$850,000). The largest bequests were the sum of £20,000 to his nephew, Henry Hamilton Kitchener, and the Broome Park estate and all lands in Kent county to his nephew, Colonel Henry Francis Chevallier Kitchener of the royal navy, a son of the new earl. The will makes a number of smaller gifts to relatives and friends, including £200 each to several officers who served on Lord Kitchener's personal staff. Among these was Gen. Sir William R. Birdwood. To Col. Oswald A. G. Fitzgerald, Lord Kitchener's personal military secretary, who was drowned with the field marshal, was willed all Kitchener's lands in British East Africa, amounting to about 5,000 acres, with plantations, etc. Swords of honor, plate and other gifts from public bodies are devised as heirlooms in settled estates. The will was dated November 2, 1914.
