SCOFFS AT SHARK PERIL.
Danger About Equal to That From Lightning, Scientist Asserts.
NEW YORK, August 26.—To satisfy the extraordinary interest in sharks, due to the appearance of the fish in large numbers on the north Atlantic coast this summer, and the death of three bathers from this cause, the American Museum of Natural History today opened a special exhibit showing a man eaten, a blue shark and a ground shark.
"All sharks which have been captured around here since the shark scare," said J. F. Nichols, assistant curator of the museum, who planned the exhibit "have been undoubtedly this common ground shark." Visitors to the exhibit are greeted by the following printed notice: "The danger of being attacked by a shark about here is probably less than that of being struck by lightning."

WOMEN USED TO LURE BUYERS.
New York Manufacturers Under Suspicion by District Attorney.
NEW YORK, August 26.—District Attorney Swann announced today that he had assigned one of his assistants to make a special investigation of evidence that manufacturers here are employing women to attract buyers who come to New York from all parts of the country. The district attorney's office has been engaged in an effort to stamp out the practice of "white slavery." Mr. Swann said that he had unearthed enough facts to convince him that men who induce women to come to New York to sell their wares to buyers may be induced to white slavery.
