My Dear Mr. Fuller: I began at your school at the very beginning in both shorthand and typewriting and worked up in the two branches, finally teaching shorthand for a while at the Drillery, until I went to Michigan. On March 24, 1915, I passed my civil service examination in Michigan, with an average of 89.20, ranking first from Michigan and fourth from the whole United States. In February, 1916, I received a temporary appointment in the Department of Agriculture, which, on April 1, materialized into a permanent one in the same department. This, I feel, was due in a large measure to the thorough instruction which I received at the Drillery, and I recommend that school very strongly to any prospective pupil wishing to fit as a stenographer for a position either in or out of the government.
