

DISTRIBUTION OF INVESTMENTS.



NOTES OF PROGRESS IN LATIN AMERICA

The Argentine government has recently authorized, by decree in the Boletín Oficial, the Argentine Portland Cement Company (Compania Argentina de Cemento Portland) and the Petroleum Transporting Company (Compania Transportadora de Petroleos) to operate in Argentina as stock companies.

The statistical bulletin of the republic of Panama issued in July, 1916, gives the total value of the exports from that country in 1915 as \$5,545,302. Of this amount, \$3,118,754 was shipped to the United States.
