At a meeting of the District of Columbia Bankers' Association, held Wednesday evening, May 23, the undersigned (constituting all the national banks, trust companies and savings banks in the city of Washington) agreed to lend to anyone desiring to purchase a \$100 United States Liberty Loan Bond, \$90, to be paid in monthly installments of \$10 each; and to anyone desiring to purchase a \$50 bond, \$45, to be paid in monthly installments of \$5 each; such loans to bear interest at the rate of 3½ per cent per annum, or at such other rate as the Liberty bonds may bear.
