

THE REASONS FOR OPPOSING WAR

Senator La Follette Says U. S. Had Insufficient Grievance Against Germany.

HEARER CALLS HIM YELLOW

By the Associated Press. ST. PAUL, Minn., September 21.—Senator Robert M. La Follette of Wisconsin told a large audience gathered at the closing session of the producers and consumers' conference last night that he was opposed to war, that he thought Germany had been rather rough with the "technical" rights of American citizens, but that he did not think the exercise of these technical rights in traveling on belated munitions laden with munitions, was worth going to war about.

Hits Big Business. "Who is abroad crying in the loudest tones? Business, which is making money. The new projects of patriotism are misquoting in the livery of heaven while you are serving the devil. I have just come from Washington, where, with a little handful of men, I have been waging a fight, demanding that taxation should be laid according to the ability to pay."

Defends Sinking of Lusitania. When the senator, in making his declaration that the United States should never have entered the war, sought to defend the sinking of the Lusitania, there came cries of "You're yellow."

Criticizes the Tax Bill. The senator criticized the tax bill recently passed by Congress. Other speakers in the evening were A. C. Townley, president of the Non-Partisan League, and Mayor Van Lear of Minneapolis.

TESTIMONY IS FINISHED IN RUSS GENERAL'S TRIAL

Wife of Gen. Soukhomlinoff Protests Against Baring Life to World. Prosecutor Sums Up Evidence.

PETROGRAD, Thursday, September 20.—The taking of testimony in the trial of Gen. W. A. Soukhomlinoff, former minister of war, who is charged with treason, and his wife, the latter charged with being an accessory, was finished today. Prosecutor Nosovitch in summing up the evidence declared that when the investigation of Gen. Soukhomlinoff's affairs began there was no thought that the charges would include spy work and treason. The evidence, however, he declared, led constantly to the close connection of Gen. Soukhomlinoff and his wife with Col. Malinoff and other notorious spies.

GUARD HEALTH OF PEOPLE. Nurses Assigned to Duty in Zones Around Army Cantonments.

Fifty public health nurses have been assigned for duty in the zones around the National Army cantonments, National Guard camps and naval bases. The American Red Cross war council announced yesterday afternoon that they would work in co-operation with local, state and federal health authorities in an endeavor to prevent spread of tuberculosis, malaria and other diseases.
