GERMANS CAN STRENGTHEN ARMY BY RETREAT ON LINE OF MEUSE

TOTAL OF TICONDEROGA DEATHS PLACED AT 213

Two officers and ninety-nine enlisted men of the Army lost their lives in the sinking of the American steamer Ticonderoga in the war zone September 30. This announcement today by the War Department shows the total loss of life to 213, the Navy having previously reported ten officers and 203 men of the crew dead. The officers lost were Lieutenants Joseph W. Freeman of Wetumpka, Ala., and Cleveland C. Frost, Berea, Ky. Umberto Dies While in Army. ROME, October 22.—Prince Umberto, Count of Salaparuta, cousin of King Victor Emmanuel, is dead at Crescenno, near Monte Grappa, where he commanded a battery in the Italian army. He was twenty-nine years old.

Further delay in paying employees of the public school system of the District was disclosed today by the complaint of a grade school principal that the principal's session room pay checks, usually received shortly after the monthly pay checks are disbursed, have not been sent out by the auditor. Principals are allowed what is termed "session room pay," amounting to \$30 per month for each room he teaches, paid in monthly additions to his salary, but made out on a separate pay roll. A school official today said that the delay in the disbursement of the checks for "session room pay" is a yearly occurrence at this time and owing to the fact that the principal's pay for the year and the necessity of making out a much more involved session room pay check were later than usual. All school employees were paid on October 19.

TO OWNERS OF PASSENGER AUTOMOBILES:

Beginning Monday, October 21, and until further notice, owners of passenger automobiles are earnestly requested and expected to co-operate with the governmental emergency committee in order to help eliminate the influenza and to facilitate the transportation of war workers to and from their offices. To this end owners will attach to windshields the following notice, obtainable at police headquarters, stations and substations, government departments, gasoline filling stations, garages and automobile establishments:

WAR WORKERS 7-9:30 4:30-6:30

War workers may hail any car not already filled as to seating capacity, going in the direction indicated on windshield, from 7 to 9:30 a.m. and from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. A car hailed is expected to take up passengers to seating capacity unless going on pressing errand of mercy or necessity. If unable to stop for one of above reasons occupant will so indicate. This request does not apply to licensed public vehicles. Only war workers have the privilege of hailing cars. The police will co-operate in supplying windshield notices, facilitating prompt passage of automobiles so employed and in preventing abuses of privileges provided. E. B. WAR WORKERS

Members of the Senate who allowed themselves to be quoted in regard to the German note today with unanimity condemned it as unsatisfactory. Senator Hitchcock, in my judgment, chairman of the Senate foreign relations committee, said that while the German government apparently has accepted all the requirements laid down by President Wilson, he did not believe the reply would lead to an immediate armistice. The note appears to be an acceptance of the President's stipulations, said Senator Hitchcock. "In my judgment, however, it will not lead to an armistice immediately. I think the military authorities will probably make conditions so hard that Germany will hesitate to accept them, and that this will lead to a delay in negotiations over an armistice. In the meanwhile war will go on."

SENATOR THOMAS

The District liberty loan committee today estimated that complete reports from all banks will show Washington's total subscription to the fourth liberty loan slightly more than \$42,000,000. John Poole, chairman of the committee, said that practically none of the banks had finished tabulating its sale sheets. Final reports, however, are not expected to raise the total much above the estimate of \$42,000,000. This estimate includes \$5,000,000 in Navy subscriptions, received at the Navy Department from sailors at sea and cleared through local banks. With this Navy allotment deducted, the people of Washington themselves invested \$37,000,000 in the loan, or nearly ten million more than the city's quota of \$27,600,000. Approximately 150,000 Washingtonians bought bonds. Feat Termed Brilliant. Chairman Poole today characterized as "brilliant" Washington's feat of going ten million past its quota in spite of the epidemic which cast a cloud of depression over the city. Employees of the Treasury Department in Washington subscribed \$3,771,700 to the loan, more than the combined subscriptions of this department in the three previous issues. Latest reports from the Boy Scouts of Washington indicate that they sold \$282,200 worth of bonds and \$429 in individual sales. This is regarded as an excellent record, in view of the fact that the scouts did not begin soliciting until after the war had begun. The city post office stands 95 per cent perfect in the fourth liberty loan campaign. Postmaster Charles H. H. L. 1,142 possible subscribers. Employees bought a total of \$128,550 worth of bonds, more than any other group who did not subscribe, it is declared, had pledged, but was taken ill with the influenza and was not present. Delivery Boys Do Well. Forty-two special delivery boys of the office bought \$3,450 worth of bonds. Frank C. Skinner, chairman of the patent office, reported that employees of that department bought \$182,550 worth of bonds of this loan, an increase of \$44,950 over the amount they purchased in the previous issue. Of the 407 employees, \$16 bought bonds, \$114 bought bonds, and \$127 bought \$149,050 and women \$25,500.

U. S. DORMITORIES CHARGES SET LOW

Girl workers will pay but \$45 monthly, including two meals. Girl war workers to be housed in the government dormitories on the Union station plaza will be charged not more than \$45 a month for a room, including two meals on week days and three meals on Sunday. This announcement was made by the United States Housing Corporation today, in connection with a notice which it sent to all government bureaus in Washington, asking them to submit as soon as possible a list of employees who want accommodations in the new residence halls. Ask for Apportioning. This method of listing applications for the dormitories was made in order that the rooms would be properly apportioned among the bureaus. A letter sent to the bureaus by Alfred S. Amer, general manager of the dormitories, asks that these lists of applicants be submitted not later than November 1. It is suggested that applicants be numbered on the list so that in the event that there are more applicants than the dormitories can accommodate, the rooms may be allotted to those who first applied in each bureau. After the lists are received from all bureaus, the Housing Corporation will allot a certain number of rooms to each bureau. Fear Flooding to New Quarters. Whether or not the Housing Corporation will take steps to prevent a rush of war workers from the homes of the city into the dormitories is not known. No reference to this plan was made in the notice issued today. If the price of \$45 a month for room and board should cause girls to flock to the dormitories, the United States home registration service would have to close its doors to the private homes again for workers who arrive in future. The dormitories on the plaza will accommodate 1,944 women, chiefly in single rooms, and will be ready some time in December. The dormitories at 22d and B streets, which will be ready in February, will provide for 1,600 women. Accommodations also will be provided in the new buildings at 1,400 persons in small kitchenette apartments of three and four rooms.

If the decrease in the number of new cases continued, it was said that the order closing theaters and moving picture houses may be rescinded at the beginning of next week. Hundreds of chorist girls, thrown out of work by the closing of the theaters, have found employment in the restaurants, candy stores, cigar stores and munitions plants.
