EXHIBIT AT FOREIGN FAIRS, U. S. ADVICE

Dr. Huntington Has Project for Business Interests to Act Jointly.

PARIS, October 6 (by the Associated Press).—Recommendation that all business interests of the United States combine for the purpose of jointly exhibiting at great European fairs will be made immediately to the Department of Commerce by Dr. W. C. Huntington, commercial attaché at the American embassy here.

Dr. Huntington, who has just returned from an official visit to the war zone, is enthusiastic over the opportunity presented American business men to these fairs. "The exchange situation between France and the United States," he declared today, "is responsible for the difficulties of doing business in France under present conditions are too great. I believe American business men should take a more active part in these fairs, and will make recommendations to the Department of Commerce of the kind and all large English companies are represented. Studies of European fairs where American should be represented are being made, and in the near future I expect a greatly increased participation in them by the United States." There were six American exhibits at the fair at Lyons, the displays including a large variety of agricultural machinery, sanitary plumbing supplies and a unique showing of California redwood, which attracted great attention.

Dr. Huntington regards the Lyon exposition as an excellent indication of the revival of French industry, and thinks it is probable the fair will soon become a most active rival to the annual fair at Leipzig.

FRAUD FOUND IN NAPLES.

Organization Suspected of Illegally Expediting Emigration.
