

CONSTANTINE ASKS FOR GREEK SEPARATE CHANGES IN CONSTITUTION SOUGHT BY NEW KING. ADDRESSES ASSEMBLY.

ATHENS, January 5.—Changes in the Greek constitution with a view to its greater popularization were urged by King Constantine in his message to the new assembly at the brilliant ceremonial of its initial meeting today.

Queen stands at his side. Queen Sophie stood at his side as he delivered his message. The king wore the form of a field marshal with a rank baton.

Senate is Proposed. One of the changes proposed in the constitution is the insertion of clauses establishing a senate, the chamber, or body, being at present the only legislative body.

A party of soldiers, whose identity or affiliation is not known, might assassinated Col. Stefan Fatzakas who was the chief judge.
