GREEK QUEEN AIDS REFUGEES' PLIGHT
Demands Government Prevent Distress of 20,000 From Caucasus.

SALONIKI, May 10.—Queen Sophie of Greece, head of the Greek Red Cross, recently summoned members of the Greek cabinet to the palace and demanded that the government take steps to prevent the distress of 20,000 Greek refugees from the Caucasus, now in the barracks on the hills of Kalamaria near Saloniki, from becoming a national disgrace.

In consequence of her action 1,000,000 drachmas (equivalent to about \$25,000 at present rates of exchange) was appropriated for the benefit of the refugees, and fifteen additional physicians were sent to Saloniki.

The miserable condition of the refugees had been reported to the queen by Col. Olds, the American Red Cross commissioner for Europe, who inspected their camp. Queen Sophie then sent Dr. Theophanos Angelopoulos, an eminent sanitary expert, as her personal representative, to take charge of the camp. He brought a corps of ten physicians. Until that time only one physician had administered to the thousands ill among the refugees. There had been none to look after sanitation.

A. R. C. Gives Assistance.
The American Red Cross has sent to Saloniki Col. Henry A. Shaw of the United States Army Medical Corps, with a party of physicians and nurses to aid the Greek government in the care of the refugees. Col. Shaw plans to gather 1,000 of the orphans in old French barracks, several miles from the present camp, where the children will be given medical attention, while food will be furnished by the Greek government. The expenses of this work will be borne by the government.

Miss Lillian Spelman, a Boston nurse, is conducting a Red Cross dispensary at the camp, where she distributes cans of milk and soon will distribute clothing to the small children.

Many of the refugees were lured here by promise of rich lands in Macedonia, but the majority fled from the Caucasus before the advances of the bolsheviks and the Turkish nationalists under Kemal Pasha.

The 20,000 are huddled together in barracks which were not intended to hold half that number. A Red Cross inspector who visited the camp reports that disease, such as typhus, dysentery and influenza, is prevalent and that more than 1,000 of the refugees died within a month.

The Greek governor, Gen. Zavitianos, is in despair, for he expects 15,000 additional refugees to arrive soon, and says that there are more than 50,000 others trying to reach Greece. The fund appropriated by the Greek government to feed, clothe and provide medical attention will be exhausted within a month, say the relief agents.

CUSTER'S LAST STAND WILL BE REPRODUCED
Will Stage Western Massacre Preliminary to Unveiling of Statue to General.

BILLINGS, Mont., May 10.—Preliminary to unveiling the Custer monument, now under construction in the city park at Hardin, an exact reproduction of the massacre on the Little Big Horn will be staged on the site of the historic battle on June 25, it is announced by the Custer Battle Anniversary Association of Hardin. Approximately 500 Crow and Cheyenne Indians representing the Sioux will take part in the mimic battle against members of the American Legion and troops of cavalry, representing Custer's handful.

Permission has been obtained from the federal government for use of the national cemetery for the spectacle, and Gen. Hugh I. Scott of the historic 7th Cavalry has announced he will attend, as probably will Mrs. Custer. The War Department also has offered to co-operate in every way possible.

Following the "battle" there will be a basket dinner at Government Park, Crow agency, and afterward spectators, troops and Indians will go to Hardin, where the Custer monument will be unveiled with proper ceremonies.

Various addresses, a band concert, a men's chorus, with the Indians arrayed on one side and the American Legion men and cavalry troops on the other, will include a part of the ceremonial. An Indian powwow and a street dance at night will complete the day's program.

People from every part of the state, as well as many without its borders, are expected to attend, in view of the historic nature of the celebration, marking the anniversary of one of the most famous events in the west.






