#### To Can Quinces.

Pare and cut into quarters, dropping into cold water as you do this, to preserve the color. Weigh the fruit and allow three-fourths as much sugar. Cook the quinces gently in boiling water until soft. Skim out

the fruit, add the sugar to this water. Skim water well and boil till clear. Return the quinces to the syrup till heated through. Drain and put into jars. Boil the syrup ten minutes longer. Strain it into jars. Fill to overflowing and seal as usual.
