TELLS OF CRIME TRUST THAT'S LOCATED IN CHICAGO

Two more persons, a man and woman, were arrested on the South Side this afternoon in connection with Logue case.

John Faith has made an additional statement to the police in connection with the murder of Logue, the diamond merchant, in which he claims that he would have confessed his part in the murder plan earlier had he not feared "the worst band of criminals in the West," which he declares is located in Chicago.

The police are apparently taking Faith's claim of a "death trust" seriously, and expect to capture "Handsome Jack" Koettters, slayer of Mrs. Emma Kraft, his aged fiancée, in the Saratoga Hotel in November, 1912, believed to be one of the members of the "trust."

The McMullin woman, whose story led to the arrest of Faith and Harold Schneider, has revealed to First Deputy Schuettler that she first met Koettters through a matrimonial agency with which Johnny Faith was connected.

Two women said to have sheltered Koettters after the Kraft murder, were questioned by the police today. Schneider is said to have been a constant visitor at their home while Koettters was in hiding.

An attempt will be made to have "Johnny" Faith identified as the

slayer of Jebiel Janner, who was killed on July 2d while attempting to prevent a hold-up.

The story of the Logue murder told by the McMullin woman does not account for the strip of silk petticoat with which Logue was gagged and the police refuse to discuss this.

"May McMullin's" real name is declared to be Louise Roling Easton, and she is the divorced wife of Louis Easton, a saloonkeeper at 1400 Kimball avenue.
