### SULZER LEAVES IT TO GLYNN

Albany, N. Y., Sept. 20.—It is reported that the claims of Acting-Gov. Glynn have been recognized by Gov. Sulzer. The question arose in connection with the extradition of a prisoner now under arrest in Chili. Ac-

cording to Secretary Frank Tierney, Sulzer sent a letter to Glynn, through his secretary, Chester Platt, declaring that Glynn has jurisdiction in the matter.

The Sulzer impeachment trial was adjourned until Monday afternoon.
