SHIP SINKS—MANY LIVES LOST

Honolulu, March 26.—The entire crew of the inter-island steamer, Maui, is believed to have gone down with the vessel when she blew up in Pearl Harbor last night. A search was being made for survivors today, but no trace was found. The crew is believed to have numbered at least thirty.

The Maui left here with a cargo of explosives. From Fort Kamehameha it appeared that the vessel was ablaze and then a terrific explosion was

heard. The vessel blew up and sank immediately.

MISSING GIRL FOUND

Cincinnati, March 26.—Estelle Wilson, 19, of Indianapolis, for whom search had been made in several states since her disappearance four months ago, was found today in a rooming house here. She mentioned the name of an Indianapolis doctor when asked why she left home, the police say, and threatened suicide when they sent her to a hospital.
