RICH FATHERS OF NAMELESS KIDS SOUGHT IN BABY FARM PROBE

*State Investigator Virden Hurries To Springfield With
Report on Baby Farming—Promises Sensational
Exposure—Oak Park Case in Court.*

State Investigator Charles E. Virden has entered the campaign against "baby farms" and already has enough information to make people horror-stricken.

It is believed that some of these farms are working in league with shady doctors who attend unmarried mothers.

It is known that the keepers of these farms shake down mothers, and then if trouble comes up threaten exposure and the girls are forced to keep silent.

One important clean-up has been made by the arrest of Mrs. Lois Kennedy, keeper of a farm at 425 Maple avenue, Oak Park.

Fourteen children were brought in to court against Mrs. Kennedy.
