FOREIGN GIRLS SUBJECTED TO SAME TREATMENT AS KEPT WOMAN

*Pinching of Young Worker Leads To Arrest of Knab
Restaurant Manager — State Factory Inspector
Nelson Declares Against the Familiar Actions.*

"Just because a girl peels potatoes in a restaurant and don't know how to talk English, does that give her boss, the restaurant manager, a right to pinch her body as he pleases and take hold of her as though she is a paid, kept woman?"

Oscar F. Nelson, chief factory inspector of the state of Illinois, asks this question and his eyes blaze with anger. It is his answer and explanation of why he swore out a warrant for L. Merritt, the manager of Knab's restaurant at 52 W. Washington

street. Merritt gave bond yesterday and his trial was set for Tuesday in the Morals Court.

"When a working girl tells a man to keep away and shoves her arm against the man and tries to hold him off, the man is a prgty cheap specimen if he doesn't quit his game with her," said Nelson.

"The factory inspection department is not a morals squad or anything like that. I am not going to interfere with any conditions in hotels and restaurants behind kitchen doors
