GARY JUDGE FREES LOST SISTERS— TAKES LAW FROM NEW TESTAMENT

*Police Set the Men Free—Then Judge Does Same for
Women Taken In Raid—Quotes His Decision
From the Bible—A Sermon for Re-
formers Who Hound Women.*

A lawyer at Gary, Indiana, who didn't cease to be a human being when he was admitted to the bar, has just been called upon to pass judgment on a number of women arrested in police raids on houses of prostitution in the city built by the Steel Trust.

He didn't quote from musty law books. He didn't hunt through them for precedent, superstition, tradition and authority.

He didn't read them from cover to cover to find out what some other judges did under similar circumstances hundreds of years ago.

Instead of that he went straight to the New Testament and let Jesus Christ deliver the judgment on the women, by reading his decision from the Bible.

Albert E. Carver, a Gary lawyer, was appointed special judge to try cases arising out of police raids on certain houses of prostitution. The raids
