#### TO INDICT RAILROAD MAN

On a charge of conspiracy to defraud the government William C. Brown, former president of the New York Central lines, will be indicted this week by the federal grand jury. Other officials of the road also face trouble.

It is charged that they owned sufficient stock to control the O'Gara Coal Company, which was thrown into the hands of a receiver in September, 1913. At that time an investigation

was started which resulted in the revelation that officials of the New York Central and other railroads were stockholders in the O'Gara company.

Mr. Brown is 61 years old, broken in health and has been out of active service since last November.
