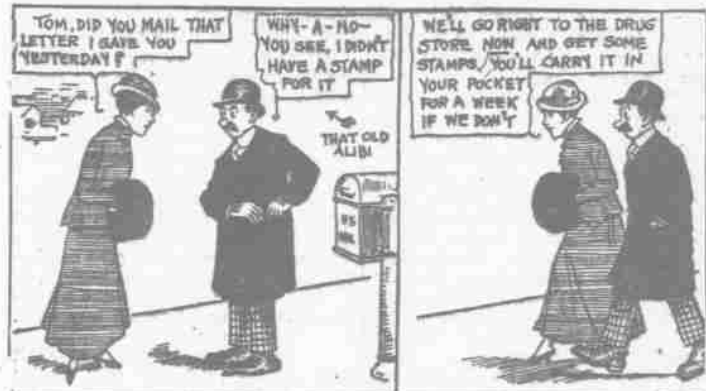


GUESS IF THEY ARE MARRIED
