LEGAL SHARKS PREY
ON EASTLAND WIDOWS

Distribution of \$356,000 Eastland Relief Fund Begins
Friday—Red Cross Officials and Bohemian and
Polish Committees Trying to Protect
Eastland Victims.

Warning to Eastland Survivors.—Don't put your case in the hands of a lawyer until you have consulted Red Cross officials or members of the Bohemian and Polish Relief Committees. Some legal sharks are trying to get their dirty feet in the relief fund trough and the beneficiaries should be protected against this raid of shyster lawyers.

The Red Cross officials and members of the Polish and Bohemian Relief Committees are trying to protect widows, orphans and other beneficiaries of the Eastland Relief Fund from a raid by hungry legal sharks who are trying to get the unfortunates to turn their cases over to these sharks, on the ground that the distribution of the public fund is not fair.

The distribution of \$356,899 will be begun by the Red Cross tomorrow, and the Bohemian and Polish Relief Committees have been closely watching every move, in order to protect the people who will benefit.
