WAS ANCONA GIVEN PROPER WARNING? U. S. ASKS

Washington, Nov. 15.—Question of fact, with contradictory official statements from Italian and Austrian governments, was squarely before U. S. today regarding sinking of Italian liner Ancona. It was more evident to administration that it must obtain its own evidence in the case regardless of Vienna and Rome.

Acceptance by Austrian government of responsibility for Ancona's attack left this government no alternative but to conduct future diplo-

matic negotiations with Austria.

Principal fact upon which any action by U. S. must be predicated was still unsolved—whether Ancona was given proper warning. Disputed question whether Ancona's lifeboats were fired on while being lowered and ship at a standstill must also be cleared up.

A report to the state department from American Ambassador Sharpe at Paris regarding sinking of Ancona gave number of survivors as 232, but did not detail circumstances of attack.
