MORE DOCTORS QUIT PHTHISIS HOSPITAL STAFF

Six more physicians last night resigned from the consulting staff of the municipal tuberculosis sanitarium, unable to swallow the Thompsonian rule.

In a letter to the mayor the resigning physicians explained that he was the cause of their leaving and referred to the "dangerous lowering of

the efficiency" of the hospital which the mayor's hand had accomplished.

"No self-respecting resident staff would tolerate the interference which would result from such a system," said one of the six, referring to the mayor's rule.
