The love of "Mammy" Jackson for Marjorie Delbridge was stronger than her fear of the law, for last night the old colored woman spirited "her chile" from the home of Mrs. Louis Brock at 6826 Cornell av. The police are looking for the pair.

"Mammy" first got the child when her mother died after she had given Marjorie over to the negro woman during her life. Later Mrs. Jackson moved to Chicago and lived at 3226 Calumet av.

Here Marjorie lived in happiness—until the juvenile court heard that she was under the negress' guardianship. Then it stepped in and after a stiff legal skirmish, took Marjorie away and awarded her to Mrs. Brock, who promised a good home.

But "Mammy" Jackson was allowed to visit the Brock home. So last night she spent the evening with Marjorie. When it came time for her to go, Marjorie walked down to the door with her—and didn't come back. Neighbors told the police that a big black auto was waiting in front of the Brock home all evening.

The police think the car was furnished by wealthy sympathizers with Mrs. Jackson.

"Mammy" Jackson was found at her Calumet av. home today, sick in bed from worry, she said, over the mysterious disappearance of little Marjorie Jackson. Marjorie was not with her. "Mammy" does not know where the little girl is, she says.
