SEARS-ROEBUCK GIVE BONUS

Sears, Roebuck & Co. took themselves out of the Marshall Field class last week when they announced they would pay a 10 per cent bonus to all employes receiving \$1,500 or less and who have been in their employe for at least three months. Following is the announcement sent to the employes.

"On account of the continuance of the unusual conditions governing the present cost of everyday needs, we will on July 1 next allow to all employes whose salary is \$1,500 per year, or less, and who shall at that time have been in our employ for at

least three months, a special compensation of 10 per cent of the total of the salary paid them for the said three months.

This arrangement will hold good for the above specified period only, and, if circumstances require that the time be extended, a further announcement will be made.—Sears, Roebuck & Co."
