GERMAN PEACE OFFER TO UNITED STATES

**Report Comes From Copenhagen—State Department
Denies Official Information—Believed U. S. Will
Stick to Allies to Finish—Bulgaria Ready
for Separate Settlement.**

London, April 12.—An Exchange Telegraph dispatch today from Lausanne asserted it was stated on semi-official authority that Bulgarian delegates were in Switzerland endeavoring to reach a basis for a separate peace with representatives of the entente.

Copenhagen, April 12.—Apparent-

ly positive reports were received here today that the German foreign office was making overtures to the United States. It was understood these negotiations sought peace between the two nations.

No further details were available here.

Official circles manifested the most intense interest in the report.
