

LEASING THE PUBLIC DOMAIN.

Address by C. E. Wantland Before the National Live Stock Convention at Fort Worth—A Subject of Great Importance to Stockmen.

Of the addresses delivered at the stockmen's convention at Fort Worth...

Mr. Wantland said: Stockmen will, of course, vote for or against this as they may feel it will affect their personal interests.

The fact that this resolution has been presented in the form in which it appears shows that the committee believe it to be to their advantage to lease and control their lands, and that there is no danger now and here of overstocking the ranges, and that to have under control would tend to preserve the grasses.

During the last few years the owners of live stock have secured many leases of State land grants from the arid States. At present the demand is greater than probably 5,000,000 acres than can be supplied, and the rentals being paid are in many cases higher than leases will be able to pay in another period of low water.

The resolution brings up squarely for decision this question: Shall any lease be favored? And if voted down it means that the National Live Stock association favors under the present conditions a state of affairs generally admitted to be unsatisfactory, defective land laws, practically putting a premium on perjury, conflicts over range rights, which constantly result in loss of life and property—lessees and the whole situation practically challenging the honesty and intelligence of Western men.

SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE. FITZSIMMONS SAYS HE WAS DRUGGED

The Offense Committed Against Him While Fighting Jeffries.

FORGOT HIS ANTAGONIST. For the First Two Rounds of the Great Battle He Was Feeling Splendidly, but Grew Hazy After Drinking.

A dispatch from New York today says that Robert Fitzsimmons, now proclaims that he was drugged when he was whipped by James Jeffries for the championship of the world at Coney Island last June.

In an interview last night Fitzsimmons said: "It is impossible for me to point to the man who was responsible for my condition on the night of June 8, when I fought Jeffries, but this I do know, and I say it with emphasis and with full knowledge of the consequences, I was drugged by some one, and it is only natural to suppose that there was a conspiracy arranged to accomplish my defeat.

"In the second, it will be remembered, I was knocked down. That blow did not hurt me, and, in fact would not have even staggered me had it not caught me just at a moment when I was resting for a moment. I came up not in the least dazed, and was feeling as good as new when I went to my corner.

"During the rest of the second and third rounds I took a drink of mineral water, and following that I have only a hazy recollection of one or two incidents of the fight.

"Just how I got through the third round I cannot tell, but when I went to my corner I struck me as a very good job, and I was there fighting before a great crowd with a man I did not know. I asked Julian what it was all about and who I was fighting with. They told me that when he said 'Jeffries' I expressed my surprise and said that I had no reason for remembering him. But of all things I remember nothing.

"Then, again, in the tenth round, in a hazy way, I remember Julian saying 'stand up, Fitz.' I stood up, wondering what it was all about, and what particular reason Julian had for wanting me to stand up at that time.

"The next day I was physically as well as I was before I went into the fight. My upper lip was a trifle puffed, but aside from that I was unhurt. But my mind was almost a blank and continued so for nearly two months. This condition gradually wore away and little by little I regained my former strength of mind.

"Finally when the affairs of the night of the fight began to become tangible I made an inquiry and I believe that I discovered how the drug was administered. I provided for my use during the fight a lot of mineral water in bottles. As the gas was likely to distress me, I told Julian to uncork the bottles and let them stand for some time so that the gas might escape. He told me that he had done this, that he had given the water to Clark Ball, who took it into the box office to guard it. Ball told me that while he was in the box office and had to be under his care two of the men who were most prominent in backing Jeffries entered the room. One of them engaged him in earnest conversation, and for a moment he lost sight of the other. He did not say that the water was drugged at that time, but he thought so now, but I am convinced that the drug was given to me in that water."

FOUR TEAMS IN CHICAGO. Probable Effect of New Move of National Baseball League.

The Chicago Times-Herald today says: "What effect the new move of the National league will have on the local baseball situation is, of course, only to be conjectured. Should the intention of the magnates to 'double up' be put into effect, it in all likelihood will be three teams for Chicago. The American league has by no means given up its intention of locating in Chicago, and President Johnson affirmed last night in Kansas City that Chicago would no doubt be in the reorganized American league. Then should the real American association also decide to put a club in this city there would be four full fledged ball teams in Chicago."

BASEBALLISTS INTERESTED. Meeting of the Prospective New American Association Today.

The New York Times says today: "The club owners of the National league and American association of baseball clubs have much interested in the meeting of the prospective new American association, which is scheduled to be held in Philadelphia today. If the association is successfully launched and McGraw and Robinson assume the management of the rival club in Baltimore it will aid the National league in reducing the circuit to eight clubs."

As the affairs of the National league now stand, the Baltimore club is the only obstacle to prevent the adoption of an eight club circuit. The circuit committee of the Major league considers the determination of nearly all the players of the Baltimore club to desert the National league for the Baltimore club without a team, and as the new club in Baltimore has secured the ball grounds the Baltimore club is without assets and has practically nothing to offer for the money consideration asked some time ago to drop out of the league. The league was ready to pay a reasonable price to the Baltimore club for its players and franchise, despite the denials of several club owners that such a plan had been arranged.

The management of the New York club claim that the chances of the circuit of eight clubs this season are very favorable. The club shows that the circuit at present has already been reduced to nine clubs, Cleveland and Louisville having been disposed of, and Baltimore being without a team or grounds.

The Baltimore-Brooklyn combine is not at all worried about the situation, apparently. It is probably awaiting the result of today's meeting, and believes, as many other club owners do, that the new association is a myth, as up to the present time there has not been enough pledged to organize a single club, and it requires a vast amount of
