The solar eclipse of May, 1900, cast a partial shadow, or penumbra, over a belt about the rate of some four miles more than 2,000 miles an hour. H. Helm Clayton has made a summary of the observations, showing that the umbra, or small total shadow, was followed at a distance of 100 miles by a cold area, in which the fall of temperature was over 5 degrees.
