APRIL RECORD OF DIVIDENDS

Six Utah Mines Distributed \$293,000 During the Month.

PARK CITY LEADS AGAIN.

Unprecedented Activity Being Displayed in the Camp-Metal Market in a Gratifying Condition.

Exclusive of a number of close corporations, from which no reports are received, a half dozen Utah mines declared dividends during the month of April. This "big six" distributed among its shareholders just exactly \$293,000, as follows: The Daly-West, \$108,000; Silver King, \$100,000; Con. Mercur, \$30,000; Grand Central, \$25,000; Annie Laurie, \$25,000 and the Sacramento, \$5,000.

Mining stocks were affected by a further decline in silver today. Nearly all of those which displayed so much buoyancy during the past week were quoted lower. Daily-West sold down to \$47.20 on the open board, which was just \$1.30 under yesterday's highest figure.

Encampment Wage Scale.

The mine owners of the Grand Encampment district have announced the following new scale of wages: Machine men, eight hours a day, \$4; machine helpers, eight hours, \$3.50; timbermen, eight hours, \$3.00; trammers, eight hours, \$3; muckers, eight hours, \$3; sixteenth men, eight hours, \$4; tool dressers, nine hours, \$2.50; carpenters, underground, eight hours, \$4; laborers, surface, ten hours, \$3; engineers, compressors, ten hours, \$4.

Clark's New Bute Smelter.

An Associated Press dispatch from Butte says: It is reported on excellent authority that Senator W. A. Clark intends to erect a new smelter here which will treat copper ore of which zinc is a component part. There are many good properties here and heretofore, the ore which is hard to treat because of the zinc contained in them.
