more liberal distribution of the present water supply and that the city make further effort to secure some primary right for said lots and transmit the same through the Sevier valley canal that it may become a permanent right controlled and distributed by the city as the city spring is now distributed. They also petition for a small allowance from the city spring in times of drought to the extent of one watering in August and one in September. There is something like 120 such "dry lots" representing the petition lying north and west of the city.
