

CHINA WILL NOT RECOGNIZE TREATY

Won't be Bound by Agreement About Manchuria on Which She Has Not Been Consulted.

SHE SO NOTIFIES THE POWERS

Calls for No Reply—Did Not Ask to be Represented at the Peace Conference.

Washington, July 20.—China's official notification to the powers that she will not recognize any agreement regarding Manchuria...

China has not taken this step for several reasons. The Chinese government is anxious that, so far as possible, both belligerents be allowed to negotiate directly with each other...

Before sending this notification, the Chinese government addressed to its viceroys, governors and diplomatic representatives...

On one point these replies were singularly in accord—that this restoration should be made unconditionally. It was suggested that the Chinese should daily declare open to the world's gaze several additional ports in Manchuria...

There are, however, elements at Peking which are uneasy regarding the result of the Washington conference, and the Peking government has reiterated its opposition to any participation in the negotiations by China...

Gov. Higgins Sends Message to New York Legislature Recommending One be Made.
