OPEN BOARD SALES LIGHT.

Bulk of Trading Was During the Regular Call and Utah Stocks Were Favorites.

Business was active on the floor of the local exchange this morning. The bidding at times was brisk and the market showed considerable evidence of strength.

There was no particular excitement in any one security, although a number of stocks gained a point or two during the session. Nevada Hills sold at \$3.35 to \$3.42 on the open board.

PHOENIX ORE IS BEING TESTED.

Another Bingham Company Preparing to Provide Mill Facilities.

GOOD PROGRESS BEING MADE.

In Driving New Tunnel—Mine Conditions Never Looked as Well As Now.

The Phoenix Mining company, of which Andrew G. Bingham is president and principal stockholder, is conducting a series of tests with ore in a small experimental plant built a few months ago for that purpose.

It is the intention to erect a larger plant down in Carr Park canyon at a point near the company's power plant. While the matter has not been definitely decided, it is likely that the new mill will have initial capacity for the treatment of 100 tons of ore per day.

Conditions at the Phoenix mine are decidedly satisfactory to its owners at the present time, and developments made during the present year indicate that it will eventually become one of the big producing mines of the camp.

The main tunnel which was started into the mountain just across the gulch from the power plant, about a year ago, is now in about 150 feet and has encountered considerable ore of a milling grade, but it has not, as yet, reached the point where high grade values may be expected.
