FRANK W. HILL, HARRIMAN'S CLERK, PLEADS GUILTY.

New York, May 29.—Frank W. Hill, former secretary to E. H. Harriman, who some time ago sold to a newspaper the now famous Signal, Wednesday letter, written by Mr. Harriman, and the publication of which drew heated denial from President Roosevelt, today pleaded guilty to a violation of the penal code, which prohibits making public of private documents by confidential employees.

On the recommendation of the district attorney's office, the request of Mr. Harriman's sentence was suspended.

CUSTOM HOUSE RETURNS. New York, May 29.—The custom house returns of the total exports from New York for the week ending May 25, show a decline in the percentage effect of the longshoremen's strike upon commerce as diminishing.

The returns for the week ending May 11, which was computed before the effect of the strike was felt, showed the value of the exports to be \$13,400,000. During the week ending May 18, when the strike was most severe, the value of the exports fell to \$6,456,000. The returns for the week ending May 25 show that the value of the exports was \$9,758,532—an increase of more than \$3,000,000 over the previous week.

The steamship companies are confident from these figures that the strike is having less effect upon the trade on behalf of all of the lines, reflecting that by the end of this week little will be left of it, so far as its influence on traffic is concerned.
