## RICHARDSON HAS HOUSE FOR DARROW

### Declares His Closing Speech in The Haywood Trial Was Simply Rank.

### CANNOT ENDURE METHODS.

### Has Withdrawn from Defense of Officials and Others of the Federation of Miners.

### Nugent is Also Out and the Chicago Socialistic Attorney Has Been Given Full Charge.

Denver, Aug. 2.—The News today says that Atty. E. F. Richardson of Denver, who was one of Haywood's counsel in the famous trial at Boise, Idaho, has withdrawn from any further connection with the defense of officials and others of the Western Federation of Miners in suits now pending before the Idaho courts. He is quoted as saying that he will not work with anyone who will not work with Clarence Darrow, the Chicago lawyer, associated with him in the case, any longer.

"The whole sum and substance of the matter is that I cannot endure Darrow's methods," said Richardson. "I do not sanction Socialism, at least not as it is coupled with the trying of a legal suit, especially when that case is a murder case and means a man's life. Darrow's slogging speech in the Haywood trial was rank. It was enough to hang any man, regardless of his innocence or guilt."

The News says that advice from Boise, received last night, as to the effect that Atty. Richardson and Nugent had been dropped from further connection with the remaining cases and that Darrow had been given full charge.

prohibition against Judge Cook who filed on behalf of one of the six carmen indicted June 26 by the grand jury on charges of felony alleged to have been committed in a streetcar riot. This decision will apply to all six cases.

The attorneys for the indicted officials of the United railroads also appeared in the chambers of the supreme court yesterday after the filing of the Halsey petition, and announced their intention of filing similar briefs.

The petitioners in praying for the writ rely largely upon the opinion given recently by Judge Cook on a motion to quash the indictments in the cases of the strike rioters. In his opinion Judge Cook held that the acts of the grand jury since Cook's ruling were null and void. Judge Cook refused at the same time to set aside the indictments, suggesting that the whole question be passed up to the supreme court. This question is now before that body, and the indicted ones do not desire their trials to proceed until a decision is rendered.

## FORECAST ON NEXT POLITICAL LINEUP

### "American" Sympathizers Find Much in Administration's Record That is Unsatisfactory.

### NEW PARTY MAY BE FORMED.

### Col. Wall Entertains Views to That Effect and is Said to Favor Richard P. Morris for Mayor.

### In fixing the political complexion of the coming campaign, elements will enter which heretofore have figured in few political battles. Men of "American" party sympathies find in the party's record in office abundant reason why it should not be continued in power. Men in the Democratic party have no sympathy for a fusion movement with the Republicans for they fear that such a movement would further cripple them for the next state campaign. Republicans are little afraid to enter the battle alone, estimating their city strength by the vote of the last general election, and feeling confident of the outcome when the record of the city administration is taken into account.

### MAY FORM NEW PARTY.

### This situation leaves no hope of any two parties getting together on common ground, unless it is a case of a faction of the Democratic party and a faction of the "American" party getting together on a common basis and taking a new name, such as "Tax- payers party," or "Citizens party."

### SUPPLIES FOR PHILIPPINES.

### San Francisco, Aug. 2.—Large quantities of merchandise, ammunition and supplies of every kind for use of the army in the Philippines, are being forwarded to the islands.

### JOHN SHARP WILLIAMS NOMINATED FOR SENATOR.

### Jackson, Miss., Aug. 2.—Returns this morning from a tour of inspection last night that John Sharp Williams has been nominated for U. S. senator by 10,000 to 15,000, although the supplies of the Gov. Vardaman say that his majority will be less than 5,000 and may not go above 5,000. It will take the official count to determine the majority.

### MAY INVALIDATE OLIVER GRAND JURY INDICTMENTS

### San Francisco, Aug. 2.—The question of the validity of the many scores of indictments returned recently by the Oliver grand jury has at last been settled by the supreme court of California. The court has ruled that the "outside man" of the Pacific States Telephone company, now on trial on a charge of bribing Supervisor Logan, did not petition yesterday with the supplies court, appealing to that body for a writ of prohibition restraining the superior court and Judge Frank H. Dixon from trying his case.

## NOW FOR HEAD OF GEO. RALEIGH

### Looks Like He Will Have to Re- sign or Be Kicked Out.

### ALREADY ON ANXIOUS SEAT.

### Known As "The Middleman" His Rec- ord is Anything But a Spotted One Among the Crooks.

A number of "American" party officials and leaders felt that the removal or resignation of George A. Sheets as chief of police was absolutely necessary for the welfare of the organization. There was division in the camp over the Sheets case, and there is still dissension over it, and there is promise of considerable more trouble. But there is one matter connected with the police department in which there is little if any disagreement. It pertains to George R. Raleigh, chief of detectives.

"American" officials and workers in the city are all in favor of Raleigh's removal unless he resigns. The consensus of opinion among the members of the city council and an "American" party man, Sgt. only is Raleigh accused of complicity in the McWhirter robbery and swindle but his name has been connected with other shady transactions.

### UNSAVORY RECORD.

Readers of the "News" have not forgotten the charges made against him by gamblers and others during the last campaign. By the former he was called the "middleman." By the latter he was accused of petty grafting. At Wood's trial he was "lally" tried to compel him to buy "hot" clothes for the privilege of running a public house. It was also made a fact that a blind man, one of the protected class, but one of those who dare not close up his "shop," accused Raleigh to his face of affording protection to certain favored ones and called him "middlemen."

### SHEETS HAS REGRETS.

When Raleigh was first appointed chief of detectives, he was said to be the right hand man of George A. Sheets, chief. It was learned this morning that Sheets did not want to appoint Raleigh to that position but was forced to do so. There is reason to believe that Sheets has regretted it ever since.

### TO BLAME FOR CONDITIONS.

Raleigh comes in for a generous share of the blame for the frightful conditions now existing in the city. He is referred to as the colored thieves and vagrants now infesting the town. Robberies are of nightly occurrence and gambling houses are running practically wide open. All kinds of sporting games are running in Bruce Johnson's, Hatfield's and other joints masquerading under the title of "club." Raleigh knows where these places are, but nothing is done to break up the dives. Are these places afforded protection? If so, does Detective "Lally" get something for protection. He is also charged with conspiracy and it is understood will be charged with accepting a bribe in the McWhirter case.

### RALEIGH CRITICISED.

There is reason to believe that some action will be taken in this connection in the near future whether a successor to Sheets is appointed or Raleigh is criticised for not closing up gambling dens; for not cleaning the city of murderers, colored thieves and other scoundrels; for not stopping street walkers, who are a disgrace to the city; for not stopping the McWhirter robbery and other scandals; for not stopping the McWhirter case, as a failure in the position he occupies.
