

BRYAN FAVORS COUNTY OPTION

Wants Plank for It Put in Nebraska Democratic Platform but Old Associates Oppose Him.

ONCE ARDENT SUPPORTERS Congressman Hitchcock Declares Himself Candidate for Senate as Does Richard L. Metcalfe.

Grand Island, Neb., July 24.—Democracy of Nebraska will hold their platform convention in this city Tuesday and it promises to be of greater interest than any gathering of the kind held in this state for many years.

SITUATION UNUSUAL The situation is considered an unusual one because the men who at present are most actively opposing Mr. Bryan were formerly his strongest supporters.
