The Fort Townsend Southern. The surveying party under Chief Engineer Hoge, of the Fort Townsend Southern railroad, are busily engaged running preliminary lines between the head of Townsend bay and Quiltsen. The object is to locate the line between Quiltsen and the point on the bay at Johnson's place, so that a Pacific can be admitted to the management, which will enable them to get contracts for grading, piling and getting out the first section of the road.
