Lieutenant Rufus Huntton Tells the Story How He Became a Member of Col. Garfield's Command.

Lieutenant Rufus Huntton, of Fairbury, Ill., who is spending the winter in this city, enjoyed the personal friendship of James A. Garfield for a long number of years; in fact from his school days up to the time of his death.

Lieutenant Huntton's most valued household gods is a splendid photograph of President Garfield taken by the Smithsonian Institution, and sent to him by the president himself only a short time before the tragedy that ended his life.

Like all men who served under General Garfield, Lieutenant Huntton has a vast fund of anecdote concerning his commander. A few evenings ago, while Lieutenant Huntton was sitting with a number of Grand Army comrades in the gathering joyfully known as the Pre-parator's Club, he was asked to tell the story of his first enlistment and his service under Garfield.

"In 1859 I was a student in Hiram Eclectic Institute and James A. Garfield was one of the professors. He was an intellectual giant even among the excellent faculty then at the institute and looked above the rest as one of those Washington fir trees would tower above the trees of our Eastern forests.

He had a splendid physique and with his fair hair, bright blue eyes and that personal magnetism which attracts over all men, he thought him the model man and expected great things from him. And many of us lived to see our cherished expectations realized in the noble character of the man who was to become our president.

"When Fort Sumpter was fired upon the study was out of the question in our school which had been a hotbed of abolitionism. Books were thrown aside and the students formed a military company, and the college square became the ground for drill and maneuvers.

"One night our company gave a grand ball in the town hall and we were all there in the full glory of our gray uniforms, brilliantly bedecked with gold and colors. We were very proud of our uniforms and so were our best girls. From the onset the ball was a success, both socially and financially.

"The lamps shone over fairly and bravely. A thousand hearts beat happily, and when music arose with its voluptuous swell, soft eyes looked love to eyes that sparkled again, and all went merry as a marriage bell.

"In those days we had the good old-fashioned country dance, and we danced with vigor. A quadrille had just been formed on the floor and the music had just started up on the preliminary strain when in through the door at the end of the room stepped a tall, handsome and dashing young regimental.
