THE LAWS OF MONEY.

Laid Down by Mr. Carlisle in a Speech in Kentucky.

WE CAN'T HAVE TWO STANDARDS

The Cheaper Money Has Always Driven Out the Dearer.

Every Free Coinage Country in the World is on a Silver Basis—No Silver Basis Country Has Gold in Circulation, and None Pays Fair Wages to Labor.

Bowling Green, Ky., May 25.—Hon. J. G. Carlisle, secretary of the treasury, spoke here today in the opera house on the currency question. The seating capacity of the house is only about 700, and it was necessary to exclude women and children, voters only being admitted.

"The question is whether we shall continue to preserve our present monetary system, under which the dollars in use by the people, whether gold, silver or paper, are equal in purchasing power in all markets. The proposition of our federal government, to issue gold and silver and unlimited coinage of legal tender silver is that the United States alone, without the assistance and cooperation of any other government, shall legalize the coinage of 42 1/2 grains of standard silver into dollars, and by law compel the people of the United States to receive in payment of debts of all kinds, when, as a matter of fact, the silver contained in such coin is worth only about 35 cents, and the gold coin is worth 100 cents."

The Cutter Grant at Whatcom.

Prodigious Growth of the Sentiment for Bi-Metallism.

BISMARCK IN SYMPATHY WITH IT

The Recent Session of the Reichstag Unsatisfactory to Everyone.

The Agricultural Members, Whose Grain Monopoly Bill Was Killed, Are Unanimously For the Double Standard—The Duty on Petroleum.

Copyrighted, 1925, by the Associated Press. Berlin, May 25.—The work of the session of the reichstag which has just closed was marked by a negative character. In an unexpected parting attack on the government, just previous to the adjournment, Count von Kanitz reproached the members with this fact. He declared that the members of the reichstag might as well leave Berlin empty-handed as to return to their constituents with "deceivable pieces of legislation touching upon such and such matters." He added, could only increase the discontent in the country. The government, he insisted, had done nothing in spite of all the promises made by the ministers to relieve the agricultural districts, and he demanded that the government either draft a new bill by the autumn or accept the proposals of the agricultural districts. Baron von Manteuffel said that the whole Conservative party subscribed to the opinions on this subject of Count von Kanitz. Dr. von Boetticher, imperial secretary of state for the interior, in reply, said he regretted that so little had been done during the session, but he added that the government had not forgotten to prolong it in the face of such empty benches as had recently been seen in the house. One of the chief features of the session, which has not been without startling incidents, has been the rapid growth of the bi-metallist agitation.
