ATTACK ON THE BONDS

Attempt to Wipe Out Junior Securities of the N. P.

REORGANIZATION OF THE ROAD.

McNaught Thinks Only First Mortgage Bonds Good—Heavy Assessments Are Expected.

Wall street quotations of Northern Pacific securities have been seriously affected, says the St. Paul Pioneer Press, by news that holders of preferred stock contemplate a suit to have declared illegal nearly half the securities of the road.

The suit contemplated is based on a clause of the original charter of the road granted by the United States government in 1864, which forbade the issue of any but first mortgage bonds.

The claim is that the company acquired no additional rights or privileges in the reorganization of 1876 which would permit the issue of any bonds.

It is thought the reorganization scheme will soon come to a head, as J. Pierpont Morgan is now in New York, having only recently arrived from Europe.
