Beats Clifford by Half a Length at Saratoga.

THE VIGILANT BEING MEASURED.

May Get More Time Allowance From Defender—Wrenn and Chace Win the Tennis Match.

Saratoga, N. Y., Aug. 16.—The event of the programme was the merchants' stakes at one mile and a furlong, which was narrowed down by scratches until there remained only two horses, Santa Anita and Clifford. Santa Anita, with Perkins up, was quick to get into motion, but at the first furling in front of the grand stand Griffith brought Clifford up to front, and under a pull had a slight advantage at the quarter, where Rey of Santa Anita increased his speed. Then again a sprint which caused the enthusiasm of the crowd to stand to the highest pitch. As they neared the grand stand Perkins did some splendid riding, winning by half a length.

English Yacht Race a Failure.

Ryde, Isle of Wight, Aug. 16.—The annual race around the Isle of Wight, under the auspices of the Royal Yacht Club, for the commodore's cup, for two classes, one exceeding and one not exceeding forty-raters, the second prize, £200, to go to a yacht of the class that the winner was to have been sailed today. Later in the day the Corsair was floated.

The Vigilant Docked.

Brooklyn, Aug. 16.—The yacht Vigilant was dry-docked today in the Erie basin. John Hyslop, the yacht club's treasurer, had a long talk with A. Willard, after which he began preparations for the measuring. The Vigilant was docked at the extra weight, which will be on board during the race of the next week. She is a 40-foot sloop, and her white hull was a good bit further up from the water, and at least a foot of the bronze bottom could be seen. She seemed to float a few inches higher in the water than she did when she was at the dock at Bay Ridge, and it would not be surprising if she got more time from the Defender than has been estimated. The Defender was delayed by fog, and instead of reaching the dock at high tide, arrived too late to be docked at the same time as the Vigilant, who will be placed on the dock at high tide. The boat's measures will now be made public.

GOLD RESERVE SAFE.

The Syndicate is Buying the Bullion of the West.

TO OFFSET THE WITHDRAWALS.

Unusual Activity in Manufacturing Industries—Favorable Business Reports From All the Cities.

New York, Aug. 16.—Bradstreet's financial review tomorrow says: Activity in the New York stock market was further restricted this week by the condition of the foreign exchange and the continuance of general uncertainty. The government bond syndicate has partly met the situation by turning \$3,000,000 of gold into the treasury. Not only has the syndicate a large amount of gold on hand, but it has accumulated a considerable sum in assayed office checks, representing gold bullion derived from western mines and smelters. With these resources at its command, it is argued that the syndicate is fully able to protect the gold reserve and render recourse to a new bond issue unnecessary. The heavy business in the situation, however, is the continued strength in exchange rates and non-appearance of any supply of commercial bills.

As far as corn is concerned, conditions are believed to be less favorable than was shown by the government statement for August 1, published last Saturday.

MANUFACTURERS VERY BUSY.

An Unusual Condition of Affairs for August—The Iron Boom.

New York, Aug. 16.—R. G. Dun & Co. will say in their review of trade tomorrow: A belated season and a frozen May everything back. The heavy business which ought to have been done in May and June was pushed into July, so that the midsummer decline due in July comes in August, and it is not surprising to find the shrinkage for the month is much more conspicuous than usual. The disappointing crop reports of last Saturday, though evidently distrusted, lessen confidence in regard to the price of iron, even while speculators gain by them. Back of all doubts is the fact that the industries are doing better than anybody could have expected. The output of steel has advanced 10 per cent over 15,500,000 by another report, in either case close to the largest output in 1933. Unsold stocks were \$8,000 tons smaller, the steel companies having made a sale of \$2,000,000 worth of steel, but the actual consumption is large, and prices rise in the face of the increasing output. Bessemer iron is \$14.15 at Pittsburgh, and plates have advanced 1/2 cent over the year of steel rails in 1935 to August 1 were \$20,000 tons, and the deliveries \$22,000. Wages in this industry have been generally advanced, and strikes are few. Minor metal prices changed little, though large sales lifted Lake copper to 124 cents.

Textile imports have been very heavy and advances in cotton goods to some extent check business. The iron and steel makers are organizing for restoration of the wages paid before the panic. The sales of wool were 6,312,600 domestic and 5,275,500 foreign this month, against 12,575,57
