Section 1. Any amendment or amendments to this charter may be proposed in the city council...

ARTICLE XXII.

Officers, Terms and Vacancies.

Section 1. The elective officers of the city of Seattle shall be: Mayor, City Engineer, Superintendent of Streets, Sewerage and Water Works, an Assistant to the Corporation Counsel, a City Attorney, a Sanitary Inspector, three members of the Board of Health, a Boiler Inspector, a Librarian, a Chief of Police, a Chief of the Fire Department, three members of the Board of Public Works, three members of the Board of Education, and the city clerk...

ARTICLE XXIII.

Streets Upon Tide Lands and Sea and Lake Shores.

Section 1. All streets, avenues and other public highways shall be established upon, over or across any tide lands within the city of Seattle, or upon any water front of Lake Washington, Lake Union, Green Lake or other lakes, streams or bodies of water...

ARTICLE XXIV.

Inspections of Steam Boilers and Hoisting of Engineers.

Section 1. Whenever the mayor shall suspend any elective officer he shall immediately notify the city engineer...

ARTICLE XXV.

Competitive Examination.

Section 1. The mayor shall appoint a competitive examination board to examine and select persons for the office of city engineer...
